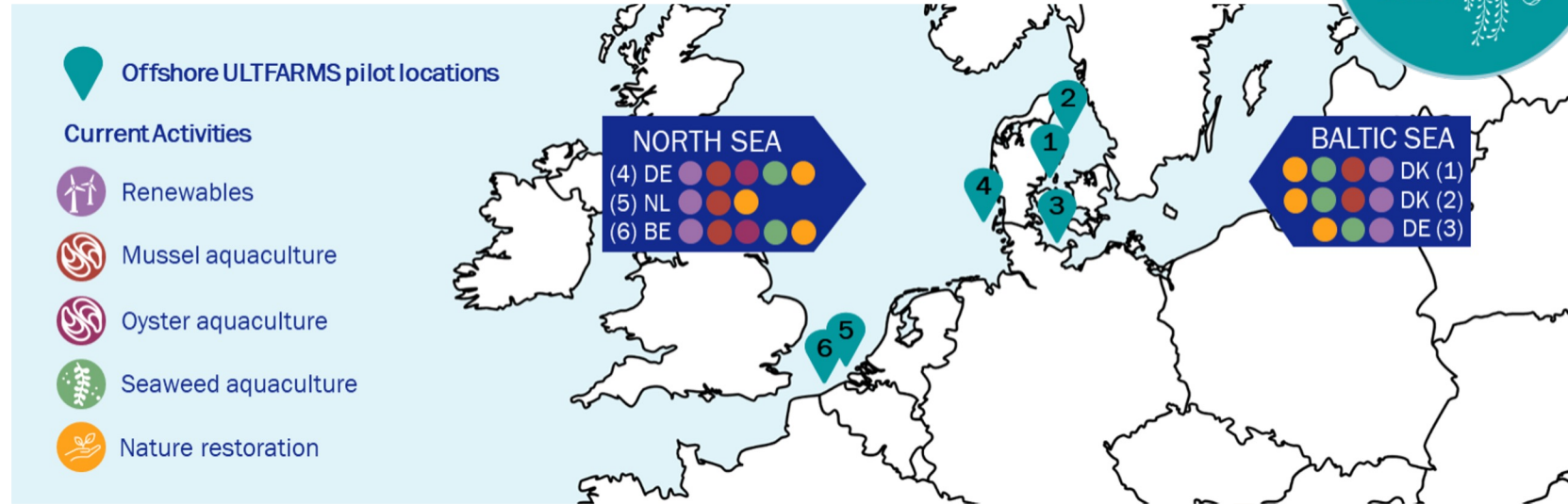

ULTFARMS Project

- Enhance **solutions to LTA farming** in combined space with **OWF for an optimal use of marine space** and synchronized offshore activities in compliance with spatial planning targets and to **demonstrate offshore LTA systems in OWF**
- To implement **efficient and cost-effective monitoring strategies** for aquaculture industry within **unified LTA systems**
- To ensure the share of **renewable energy consumption along the full value chain** of aquaculture
- To sustain **biodiversity** and to provide **suitable habitats** for fish and other biota through the inclusion of **nature restoration efforts**
- To ensure **replicability, transferability, training and capacity** building in other basins supported by a roadmap of **guidance for solution roll-out**

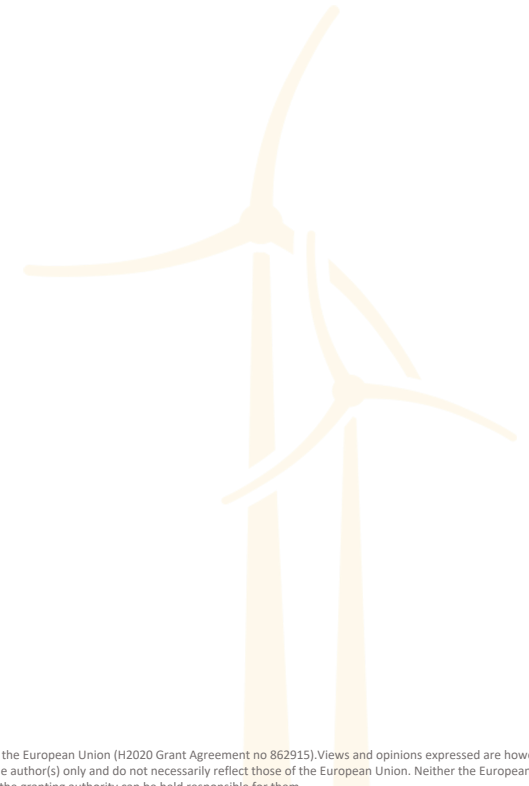
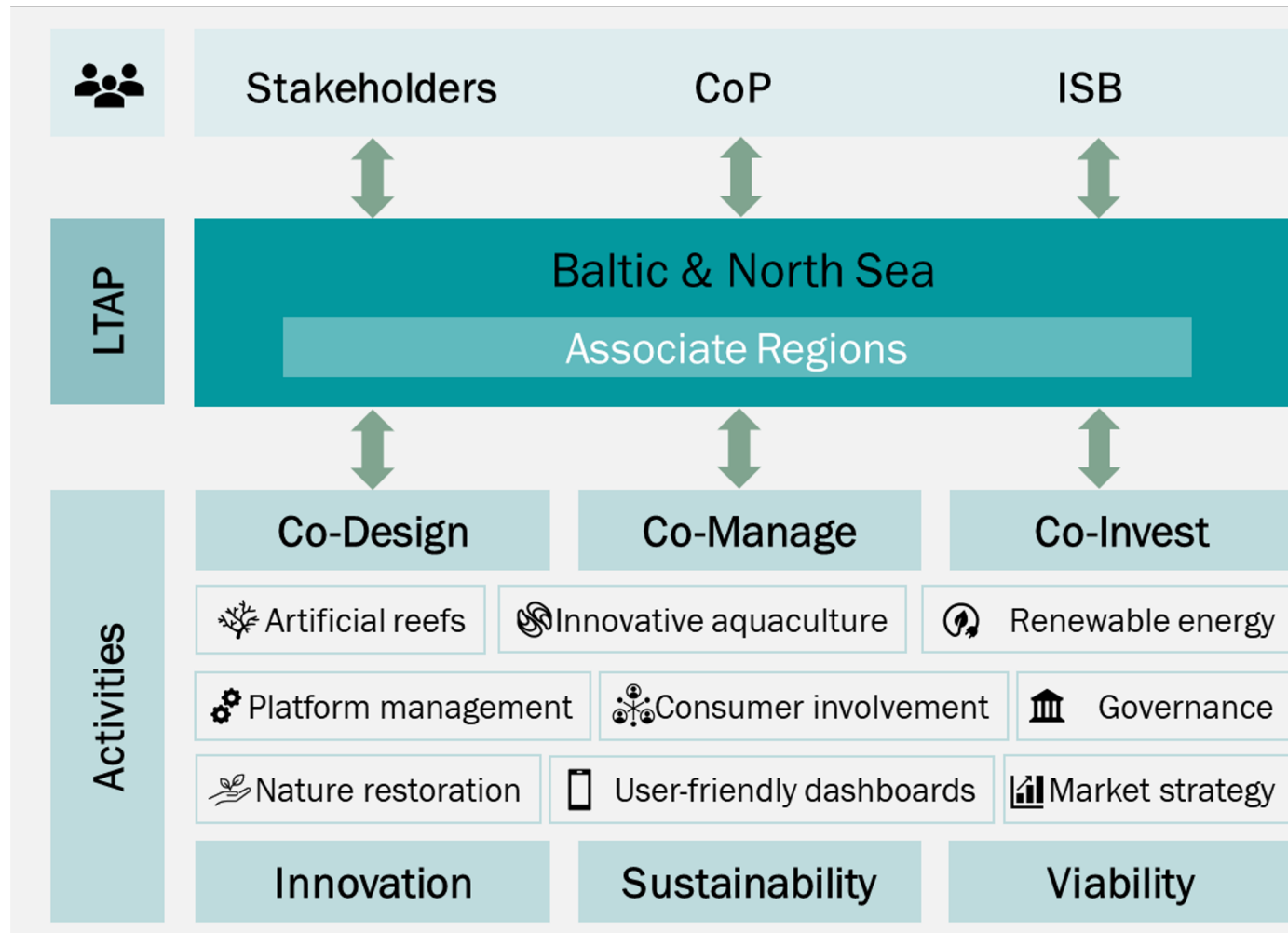

What Can Be Proposed?



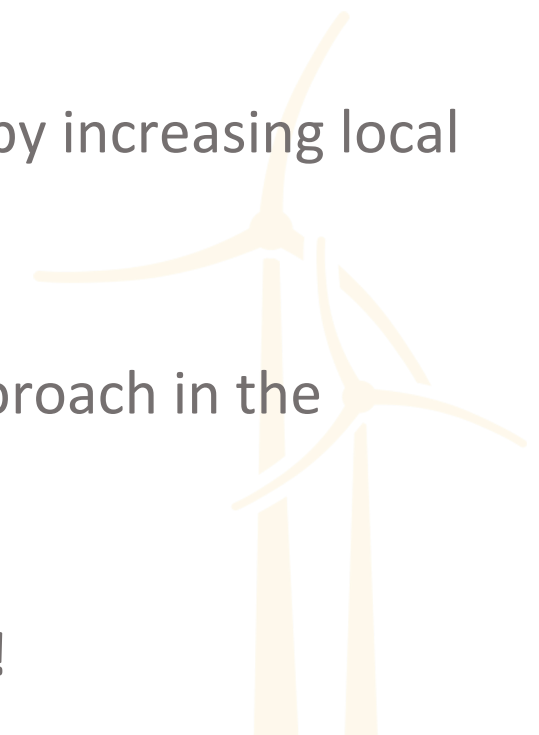
Feasibility or suitability studies for implementing Low Trophic Aquaculture

Technology or field tests for nature restoration components or Nature Inclusive Design elements related to LTA and components

Local & Regional initiatives including demonstration to solve issues by increasing local and regional societal acceptance; lowering policy barriers, etc.

Co-Development of a roadmap for application of the ULTFARMS approach in the associated region is a required output of each ARs contribution
