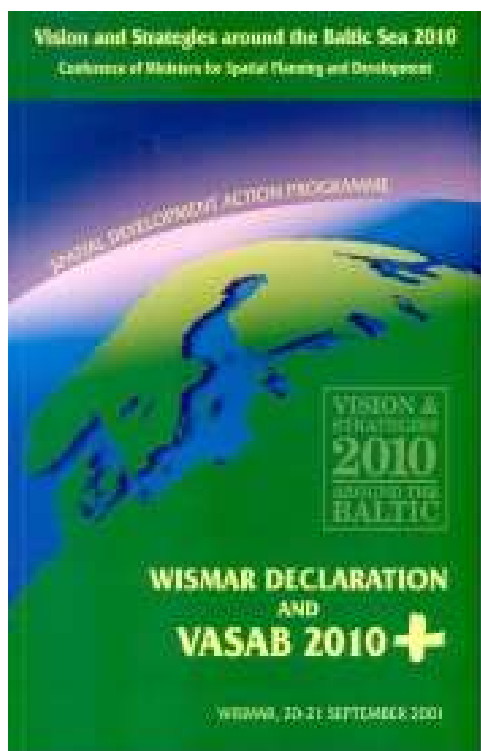

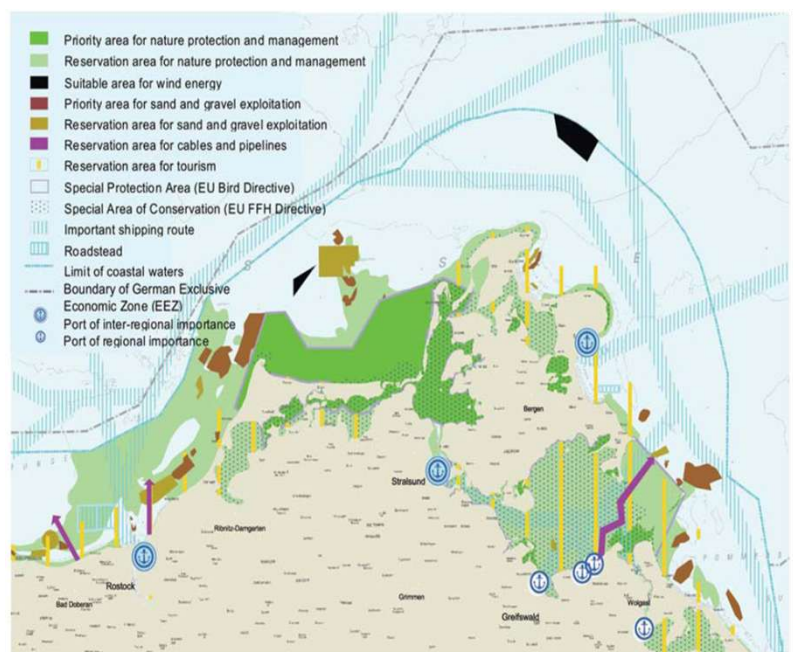

Key theme 6: Integrated development of coastal zones and islands

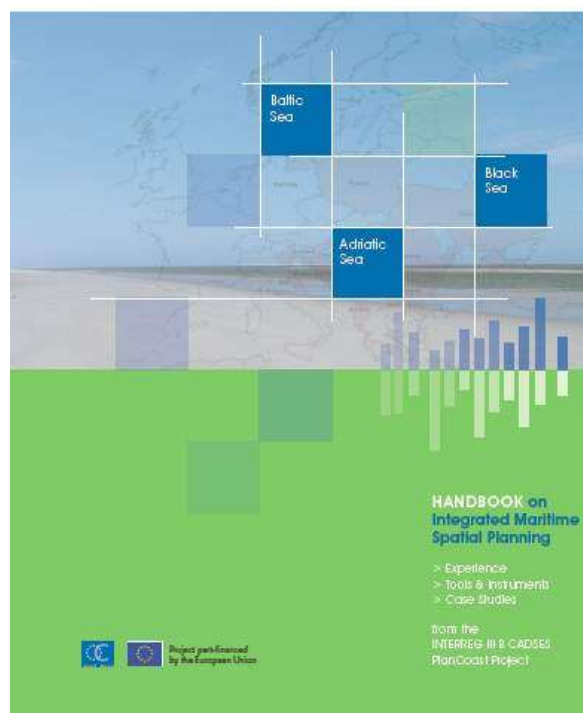
- Equally include off-shore and land side coastal areas.

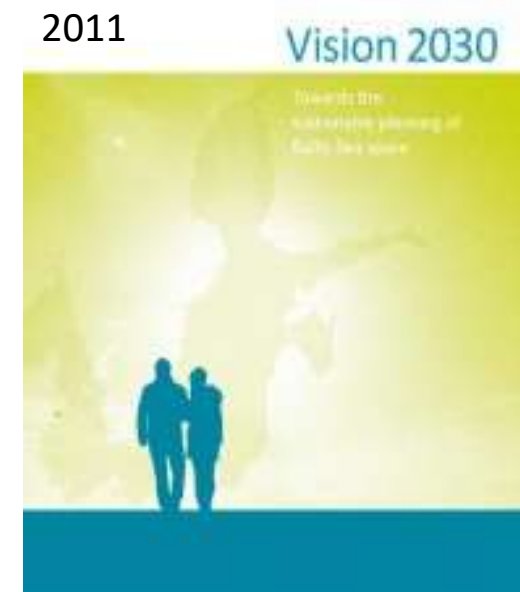
